1.0. Name of the Promotion

The name of this promotion that will be conducted in conjunction with the Mega Millions® game will be Megaplier®.

1.1. Promotion Description

The Mega Millions® Megaplier® Promotion is a limited extension of the Mega Millions® game and is conducted in accordance with the Mega Millions® game procedures. The promotion will begin at the time announced by the Lottery and will continue until discontinued by the Lottery. The promotion will offer to the owners of a qualifying play a chance to multiply the amount of any of the eight (8) lump sum set prizes (the lump sum normally paying \$2 to \$250,000) won in a drawing held during the Promotion. The grand prize in the Mega Millions® game is not a set prize and will not be multiplied.

1.2. Definitions

The definitions of the Mega Millions® game procedures apply to these procedures for the Megaplier® Promotion.

1.3. Start of Promotion

The Megaplier® Promotion will begin on January 31, 2010, with the first drawing on February 2, 2010.

2.0. Qualification for the Promotion

To qualify for the promotion (a "qualifying play"), a person must purchase a Megaplier® and pay an additional dollar per play for the Megaplier® option.

2.1. Prizes to be Multiplied

A qualifying play that wins one (1) of the eight (8) lowest set prizes (excluding the Match 5+0 prize) will be multiplied by the number selected (2, 3 or 4) in a separate random Megaplier® drawing announced in a manner approved by the MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group. The announced Match 5+0 prize for players selecting the Megaplier option shall be multiplied by four (4) unless a higher limited-time promotional multiplier is announced by the MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group. The grand prize jackpot is not a set prize and will not be multiplied.

2.2. Megaplier® Drawings

MUSL will itself conduct or authorize a U.S. lottery to conduct, on its behalf, a separate random “Megaplier®” drawing. Before each Mega Millions® drawing, a single number (2, 3, or 4) shall be drawn. The Mega Millions® lotteries may change one (1) or more of these multiplier numbers for special promotions from time to time.

2.3. Prize Pools

- A. Prize Reserve Accounts. The prize pool for all prize categories shall consist of up to 50% of each drawing period’s sales after the Mega Millions® prize reserve accounts are funded to the amounts set by the MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group. Any amount remaining in the prize pool at the end of this game shall be carried forward to a replacement game or expended in a manner as directed by the Product Group in accordance with law.
- B. Prize Reserve Accounts. Any amount not used to pay for multiplied prizes may be collected and placed in the rollover account or in trust in one (1) or more prize reserve accounts until the prize reserve accounts reach the amounts designated by the MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group.
- C. Expected Prize Payout. Except as provided in these rules, all prizes awarded shall be paid as set prizes. Instead of the Mega Millions® set prize amounts, qualifying Megaplier® plays will pay the amounts shown below when matched with the Megaplier® number drawn:

In certain instances as provided in these procedures, the Mega Millions® set prize amount may be less than the amount shown. In such case, the Megaplier® prizes will be a multiple of the announced Mega Millions® prize amount.

2.4. Probability of Prizes Being Multiplied

The probability of the various Megaplier® numbers being drawn during a single Mega Millions® drawing and a qualifying play being multiplied for the eight (8) lowest set prizes are as set forth below, except that the Megaplier number for the Match 5+0 will be at least four (4X); setting the probability of the 4X being drawn for the Match 5+0 prize is 1 in 1. The MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group may elect to run limited promotions that may increase the multiplier numbers.

2.5. Limitation on Payment of Multiplied Prizes

- A. The prize pool percentage allocated to the Megaplier® set prizes shall be carried forward to subsequent draws if all or a portion of it is not needed to pay the set prizes awarded in the current draw or may be held in a prize reserve account.
- B. If the total of the original Mega Millions® set prizes and the multiplied Megaplier® set prizes awarded in a drawing exceed the percentage of the prize pools allocated to the set prizes, then the amount needed to fund the set prizes (including the multiplied set prizes) awarded shall be drawn from the following sources and in the following order: (i) the amount allocated to the set prizes and carried forward from previous draws, if any; (ii) an amount from the Mega Millions® reserve account not to exceed the lesser of 300% of draw sales or 50% of draw sales plus \$50 million. If, after these sources are depleted, there are not sufficient funds to pay the set prizes awarded (including multiplied prizes), then the prize levels two (2) through five (5) shall become a pari-mutuel prize as set out in the Mega Millions® game procedures. The Mega Millions® and Megaplier® prize pools shall be combined in the instance when the set prizes, pursuant to the rules, are paid on a pari-mutuel basis so that the multipliers, as provided for in these game procedures, will remain in effect for all prize levels.

2.6. Prize Payment

- A. All Megaplier® prizes shall be paid in one (1) lump sum by the Lottery. The Lottery may begin paying Megaplier® prizes after receiving authorization to pay by the MUSL.
- B. Prizes which, under these game procedures, may become pari-mutuel prizes may be rounded down so that prizes can be paid in multiples of whole dollars. Breakage resulting from rounding these prizes shall be carried forward to the prize pool for the next drawing.

3.0. Governing Law

In purchasing a qualifying play in the Megaplier® Promotion, the player agrees to comply with and abide by these promotional procedures for the Megaplier® Promotion; the Minnesota State Lottery's game procedures for the Mega Millions® game; Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 349A; the Minnesota State Lottery's Prize Payment Rules and all final decisions of the Director of the Minnesota State Lottery.
