1.0. Name of Game

The name of Scratch Game No. 655 is "CASINO GAME BOOK".

1.1. Price of Scratch Ticket

- A. Tickets for Scratch Game No. 655 shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) per Ticket.
- B. A retailer may discount the sales price of a Ticket in this game if the reduction in price is part of a storewide discount promotion on all purchases (lottery and non-lottery) made by the player. The discount of the price of a Ticket shall not relieve the retailer from the obligation to pay the Lottery the full price of the Ticket as stated in this section.

1.2. Definitions

- A. "Bar Code" means the unique bar-coded representation of the game Pack-Ticket Number and the Validation Number. This Bar Code will represent 20 decimal digits that include a three-digit Game Identification Number, a six-digit compressed Validation Number, a six-digit Pack Number, a three-digit Ticket Number and a two-digit Check Code. The Bar Code will be printed in black ink and be printed horizontally across the bottom of the back of the Ticket.
- B. "Display Printing" means that area of the Scratch Game Ticket outside of the area where the Play Symbols appear.
- C. "Pack" means a pack of fan-folded "CASINO GAME BOOK" Scratch Game Tickets that are attached to each other by perforations the retailer tears when the retailer sells a Ticket. These fan-folded Tickets are packed in plastic shrink-wrapping and consist of 25 Scratch Game Tickets fan-folded by ones bearing a common Pack Number and having a Ticket number starting at 000 and continuing through 024.
- D. "Pack-Ticket Number" means the 13-digit code printed in the Pack-Ticket Number Font in black ink in positive on the back of each Ticket located above the Bar Code in the form 000-000000-0-000. The first three (3) digits are the Game Identification Number, followed by a six-digit Pack Number, followed by a one-digit Check Digit, followed by a three-digit Ticket Number. Numbering begins with 655-000001-1-000 (the 1 is an example and does not reflect the actual check digit calculation for this Pack Number).

E. "Play Symbol" means the symbols that appear under the rub-off play area on the front of the Ticket. Each Play Symbol is printed in black ink in positive. There are fourteen (14) types of Play Symbols in the "CASINO GAME BOOK" scratch game: "Aces & Deuces" Play Symbols, "Hot Slots" Play Symbols, "4 of a Kind" Play Symbols, "Casino Pair" Play Symbols, "Roulette Wheel Number" Play Symbols, "Roulette Your Number" Play Symbols, "Roll the Dice" Play Symbols, "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbols, "Black Jack Your Hand" Play Symbols, "Poker Room Cards" Play Symbols, "Lucky 7s" Play Symbols, "Your Super Slots" Play Symbols, "Super Slots" Play Symbols and "Prize" Play Symbols. The possible Play Symbols are as follows:

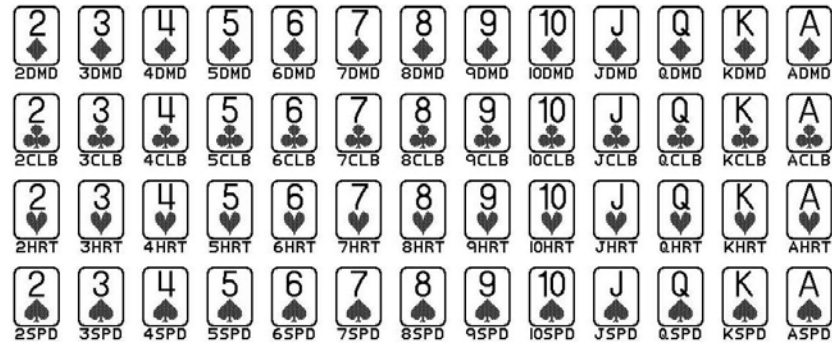

- F. "Ticket" or "Scratch Game Ticket" or "Scratch Ticket" means a Minnesota "CASINO GAME BOOK" Scratch Game No. 655 Ticket.
- G. "Validation Number" means a game-wide, unique 10-digit Validation Number printed in Validation Font in black ink in positive located on the front of the Ticket on the lower right portion and will be covered with the latex and overprint. The first nine (9) digits will be the Validation Number followed by a one-digit Check Digit.



2.0. Determination of Prizewinners





- A. The determination of prizewinners is subject to the general Ticket validation requirements set forth in Section 2.1. of these procedures and the requirements set out on the back of each Scratch Game Ticket.
- B. A prizewinner in the "CASINO GAME BOOK" scratch game is determined when the play area on the Ticket is rubbed off to expose the four (4) "Aces & Deuces" Play Symbols, the twenty-four (24) "Hot Slots" Play Symbols, the twenty-five (25) "4 of a Kind" Play Symbols, the twenty-five (25) "Casino Pair" Play Symbols, the two (2) "Roulette Wheel Number" Play Symbols, the eight (8) "Roulette Your Number" Play Symbols, the eight (8) "Roll the Dice" Play Symbols, the six (6) "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbols, the thirty (30) "Black Jack Your Hand" Play Symbols, the seventy-five (75) "Poker Room Cards" Play Symbols, the forty-five (45) "Lucky 7s" Play Symbols, the sixteen (16) "Your Super Slots" Play Symbols and the fifty-nine (59) "Prize" Play Symbols.
- C. The holder of a Ticket who has two (2)  "Aces & Deuces" Play Symbols in either of the two (2) play areas in the "Aces & Deuces" area on page 1 of 6 under the designation "Aces & Deuces" (top portion of the play area on page 1 of 6) wins the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately below the two (2)  "Aces & Deuces" Play Symbols. The holder of a Ticket who has two (2)  "Aces & Deuces" Play Symbols in either of the two (2) play areas in the "Aces & Deuces" area on page 1 of 6 under the designation "Aces & Deuces" (top portion of the play area on page 1 of 6) wins two (2) times the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately below the two (2)  "Aces & Deuces" Play Symbols.
- D. The holder of a Ticket that has three (3) like "Hot Slots" Play Symbols in any single row immediately to the right of the designations "Spin 1", "Spin 2", "Spin 3", "Spin 4", "Spin 5", "Spin 6", "Spin 7" or "Spin 8" in the "Hot Slots" area on page 1 of 6 under the designation "Hot Slots" (middle portion of the play area on page 1 of 6) wins the amount designated below:

- E. The holder of a Ticket that has a  "Hot Slots" Play Symbol in any row immediately to the right of the designations "Spin 1", "Spin 2", "Spin 3", "Spin 4", "Spin 5", "Spin 6", "Spin 7" or "Spin 8" in the "Hot Slots" area on page 1 of 6 under the designation "Hot Slots" (middle portion of the play area on page 1 of 6) wins twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each  "Hot Slots" Play Symbol.
- F. The holder of a Ticket who has any three (3) like "4 of Kind" Play Symbols in a single row to the right of the designation "Hand 1", "Hand 2", "Hand 3", "Hand 4" or "Hand 5" in the "4 of a Kind" area on page 1 of 6 under the designation "4 of a Kind" (bottom portion of the play area on page 1 of 6) wins the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately to the right of the row of "4 of a Kind" Play Symbols that contain three (3) like "4 of a Kind" Play Symbols. Only one (1) prize per hand.
- G. The holder of a Ticket who has any three (3) like "4 of Kind" Play Symbols and two (2) like "4 of a Kind" Play Symbols (Full House) in a single row to the right of the designation "Hand 1", "Hand 2", "Hand 3", "Hand 4" or "Hand 5" in the "4 of a Kind" area on page 1 of 6 under the designation "4 of a Kind" (bottom portion of the play area on page 1 of 6) wins two (2) times the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately to the right of the row of "4 of a Kind" Play Symbols that contain three (3) like "4 of a Kind" Play Symbols and two (2) like "4 of a Kind" Play Symbols. Only one (1) prize per hand.

- H. The holder of a Ticket who has any four (4) like “4 of Kind” Play Symbols in a single row to the right of the designation “Hand 1”, “Hand 2”, “Hand 3”, “Hand 4” or “Hand 5” in the “4 of a Kind” area on page 1 of 6 under the designation “4 of a Kind” (bottom portion of the play area on page 1 of 6) wins three (3) times the amount indicated by the “Prize” Play Symbol immediately to the right of the row of “4 of a Kind” Play Symbols that contain four (4) like “4 of a Kind” Play Symbols. Only one (1) prize per hand.
- I. The holder of a Ticket who has any two (2) “Casino Pair” Play Symbols in a single row to the right of the designation “Row 1”, “Row 2”, “Row 3”, “Row 4” or “Row 5” in the “Casino Pair” area on page 2 of 6 under the designation “Casino Pair” (top portion of the play area on page 2 of 6) wins the amount indicated by the “Prize” Play Symbol immediately to the right of the row of “Casino Pair” Play Symbols that contain two (2) like “Casino Pair” Play Symbols.
- J. The holder of a Ticket who has any two (2)  “Casino Pair” Play Symbols in a single row to the right of the designation “Row 1”, “Row 2”, “Row 3”, “Row 4” or “Row 5” in the “Casino Pair” area on page 2 of 6 under the designation “Casino Pair” (top portion of the play area on page 2 of 6) wins two (2) times the amount indicated by the “Prize” Play Symbol immediately to the right of the row of “Casino Pair” Play Symbols that contain two (2)  “Casino Pair” Play Symbols.
- K. The holder of a Ticket who has any three (3)  “Casino Pair” Play Symbols in a single row to the right of the designation “Row 1”, “Row 2”, “Row 3”, “Row 4” or “Row 5” in the “Casino Pair” area on page 2 of 6 under the designation “Casino Pair” (top portion of the play area on page 2 of 6) wins three (3) times the amount indicated by the “Prize” Play Symbol immediately to the right of the row of “Casino Pair” Play Symbols that contain three (3)  “Casino Pair” Play Symbols.
- L. The holder of a Ticket whose “Roulette Your Number” Play Symbol (under the designation “Your Number”) matches the “Roulette Wheel Number” Play Symbol (under the designation “Wheel Number”) immediately above or adjacent to the “Roulette Your Number” Play Symbol in the “Roulette” area on page 2 of 6 under the designation “Roulette” (middle portion of the play area on page 2 of 6) wins the amount indicated by the “Prize” Play Symbol immediately below the “Roulette Your Number” Play Symbol that matches the “Roulette Wheel Number” Play Symbol in that portion of the “Roulette” game. Each roulette wheel is played separately.

- M. The holder of a Ticket that has two (2) "Roll the Dice" Play Symbols under the designation "Your Dice" that, when combined, have a total value of seven (7) below the designations "Roll 1", "Roll 2", "Roll 3" or "Roll 4" in the "Roll the Dice" area on page 2 of 6 to the right of the designation "Roll the Dice" (bottom portion of the play area on page 2 of 6) wins the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately below the two (2) "Roll the Dice" Play Symbols whose value equals seven (7). The holder of a Ticket that has two (2) "Roll the Dice" Play Symbols under the designation "Your Dice" that, when combined, have a total value of eleven (11) wins two (2) times the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately below the two (2) "Roll the Dice" Play Symbols whose value equal eleven (11).
- N. The holder of a Ticket that has two (2) "Black Jack Your Hand" Play Symbols under the designation "Your Hand 1", "Your Hand 2", "Your Hand 3", "Your Hand 4" or "Your Hand 5" that, when the two (2) cards are combined, have a higher value than the two (2) "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbols under the designation "Dealer's Hand" in Table 1 of the "Black Jack" area on page 3 of 6 (top portion of page 3 of 6) wins the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately below the two (2) adjacent "Black Jack Your Hand" Play Symbols that have a greater value than the two (2) "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbols. The value of a    "Black Jack Your Hand" or "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbol is ten (10) and the value of an  "Black Jack Your Hand" or "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbol is eleven (11). The holder of a Ticket that has a  "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbol wins the total of all of the five (5) "Prize" Play Symbols in the Table 1 area of the "Black Jack" game.
- O. The holder of a Ticket that has two (2) "Black Jack Your Hand" Play Symbols under the designation "Your Hand 1", "Your Hand 2", "Your Hand 3", "Your Hand 4" or "Your Hand 5" that, when the two (2) cards are combined, have a higher value than the two (2) "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbols under the designation "Dealer's Hand" in Table 2 of the "Black Jack" area on page 3 of 6 (middle portion of page 3 of 6) wins the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately below the two (2) adjacent "Black Jack Your Hand" Play Symbols that have a greater value than the two (2) "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbols. The value of a    "Black Jack Your Hand" or "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbol is ten (10) and the value of an  "Black Jack Your Hand" or "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbol is eleven (11). The holder of a Ticket that has a  "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbol wins the total of all of the five (5) "Prize" Play Symbols in the Table 2 area of the "Black Jack" game.

- P. The holder of a Ticket that has two (2) "Black Jack Your Hand" Play Symbols under the designation "Your Hand 1", "Your Hand 2", "Your Hand 3", "Your Hand 4" or "Your Hand 5" that, when the two (2) cards are combined, have a higher value than the two (2) "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbols under the designation "Dealer's Hand" in Table 3 of the "Black Jack" area on page 3 of 6 (lower portion of page 3 of 6) wins the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately below the two (2) adjacent "Black Jack Your Hand" Play Symbols that have a greater value than the two (2) "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbols. The value of a    "Black Jack Your Hand" or "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbol is ten (10) and the value of an  "Black Jack Your Hand" or "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbol is eleven (11). The holder of a Ticket that has a  "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbol wins the total of all of the five (5) "Prize" Play Symbols in the Table 3 area of the "Black Jack" game.
- Q. The holder of a Ticket that has five (5) "Poker Room Cards" Play Symbols in a single row to the right of the designation "Hand 1", "Hand 2", "Hand 3", "Hand 4", "Hand 5", "Hand 6", "Hand 7", "Hand 8", "Hand 9" or "Hand 10" in the top portion of the "Poker Room" area on page 4 of 6 that contain one (1) of the nine (9) types of hands designated below wins the amount indicated below for that type of hand.

- R. The holder of a Ticket that has five (5) “Poker Room Cards” Play Symbols in a single row to the right of the designation “Hand 1”, “Hand 2”, “Hand 3”, “Hand 4” or “Hand 5” in the bottom portion of the “Poker Room” area on page 4 of 6 that contains a hand that is a pair of two (2)  of any suit, two (2)  of any suit, two (2)  of any suit, two (2)  of any suit or which contain two (2) pairs, three (3) of a kind, straight, flush, full house, four (4) of a kind, straight flush or a royal flush (as those types of hands are described in paragraph Q) wins the amount indicated by the “Prize” Play Symbol that is immediately to the right of that row of “Poker Room Cards” Play Symbols.
- S. The holder of a Ticket that has two (2) like “Lucky 7s” Play Symbols and a  “Lucky 7s” Play Symbol in any single row immediately to the right of the designations “Row 1”, “Row 2”, “Row 3”, “Row 4”, “Row 5”, “Row 6”, “Row 7”, “Row 8”, “Row 9”, “Row 10”, “Row 11”, “Row 12”, “Row 13”, “Row 14” or “Row 15” in the “Lucky 7s” area on page 5 of 6 under the designation “Lucky 7s” wins the amount indicated by the “Prize” Play Symbol in that row. The holder of a Ticket that contains two (2)  “Lucky 7s” Play Symbols in any row wins two (2) times the amount indicated by the “Prize” Play Symbol in the row that contains two (2)  “Lucky 7s” Play Symbols. The holder of a Ticket that contains three (3)  “Lucky 7s” Play Symbols in any row wins three (3) times the amount indicated by the “Prize” Play Symbol in the row that contains three (3)  “Lucky 7s” Play Symbols.
- T. The holder of a Ticket where the “Your Super Slots” Play Symbol under the designation “Your Symbols” matches the “Super Slots” Play Symbol in a horizontal, vertical or diagonal line in the Slot 1 area of the “Super Slots” area on page 6 of 6 wins the amount designated below.

2.1. Ticket Validation Requirements

- A. To be a valid Scratch Game Ticket, all of the following requirements must be met:
1. exactly four (4) “Aces & Deuces” Play Symbols and two (2) “Prize” Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the “Aces & Deuces” area on page 1 of 6;
 2. exactly twenty-four (24) “Hot Slots” Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the “Hot Slots” area on page 1 of 6;

3. exactly twenty-five (25) "4 of a Kind" Play Symbols and five (5) "Prize" Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the "4 of Kind" area on page 1 of 6;
4. exactly twenty-five (25) "Casino Pair" Play Symbols and five (5) "Prize" Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the "Casino Pair" area on page 2 of 6;
5. exactly two (2) "Roulette Wheel Number" Play Symbols, eight (8) "Roulette Your Number" Play Symbols and eight (8) "Prize" Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the "Roulette" area on page 2 of 6;
6. exactly eight (8) "Roll the Dice" Play Symbols and eight (8) "Prize" Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the "Roll the Dice" area on page 2 of 6;
7. exactly six (6) "Black Jack Dealer's Hand" Play Symbols, thirty (30) "Black Jack Your Hand" Play Symbols and fifteen (15) "Prize" Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the "Black Jack" area on page 3 of 6;
8. exactly fifty (50) "Poker Room Cards" Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the top portion of the "Poker Room" area on page 4 of 6;
9. exactly twenty-five (25) "Poker Room Cards" Play Symbols and five (5) "Prize" Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the bottom portion of the "Poker Room" area on page 4 of 6;
10. exactly forty-five (45) "Lucky 7s" Play Symbols and fifteen (15) "Prize" Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the "Lucky 7s" area on page 5 of 6;
11. exactly sixteen (16) "Your Super Slots" Play Symbols must appear under the play area of the Ticket in the "Super Slots" area on page 6 of 6;
12. each Play Symbol must be present in its entirety and be fully legible;
13. each Play Symbol must be printed in black ink;
14. the Ticket must be intact;
15. the Validation Number and Pack-Ticket Number must be present in their entirety and be fully legible;

16. the Validation Number must correspond, using the Lottery's codes, to the Play Symbols on the Ticket;
 17. the Ticket must not have a hole punched through it, be mutilated, altered, unreadable, reconstituted or tampered with in any manner;
 18. the Ticket must not be counterfeit in whole or in part;
 19. the Ticket must have been issued by the Lottery in an authorized manner;
 20. the Ticket must not have been stolen nor appear on any list of omitted Tickets or non-activated Tickets on file at the Lottery;
 21. the Play Symbols, Validation Number and Pack-Ticket Number must be right side up and not reversed in any manner;
 22. the Ticket must be complete and not miscut, having exactly one (1) Validation Number and exactly one (1) Pack-Ticket Number on the Ticket;
 23. the Validation Number of an apparent winning Ticket must appear on the Lottery's Official List of Validation Numbers of the Winning Tickets and a Ticket with that Validation Number must not have been previously paid;
 24. the Ticket must not be blank or partially blank, misregistered, defective or printed or produced in error;
 25. each of the Play Symbols must be exactly one (1) of those described in Section 1.2.E.;
 26. each Play Symbol on the Ticket must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery;
 27. the Ticket Validation Numbers must be printed in Validation Font and must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery;
 28. the Pack-Ticket Number must be printed in Pack-Ticket Number Font and must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery;
 29. the display printing on the Ticket must be regular in every respect and correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery; and
 30. none of the pages of the Ticket have been separated.
- B. The Ticket must pass all additional validation tests provided for in these game procedures, the Lottery's Prize Payment Rules and any confidential validation tests of the Lottery.

- C. Any Ticket not passing all the validation requirements may be considered void and be ineligible for any prize. However, the Director may:
1. replace the invalid Ticket with an unplayed Ticket in that scratch game;
 2. replace the invalid Ticket with a Ticket of equivalent sales price from any other current scratch game;
 3. refund the retail sales price of the Ticket; or
 4. pay the prize for the Ticket if enough of the validation requirements have been met to determine that the Ticket is not fraudulent.

2.2. Procedures for Claiming Prizes

- A. To claim the scratch game prize of ten dollars (\$10.00), twenty dollars (\$20.00), twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), thirty dollars (\$30.00), forty dollars (\$40.00), fifty dollars (\$50.00), sixty dollars (\$60.00), seventy-five dollars (\$75.00), one hundred dollars (\$100.00), two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or five hundred dollars (\$500.00), a player must sign the back of the Ticket in the space designated on the Ticket and present the winning Ticket to any lottery retailer or mail it to the Lottery at the address printed on the back of the Ticket. The lottery retailer shall verify the claim and, if valid, make payment of the amount due the player and physically void the Ticket. In the event the lottery retailer cannot verify the claim, the lottery retailer must provide the player with a claim form and instruct the player on how to file a claim with the Lottery. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, a check shall be forwarded to the player in the amount due. In the event the claim is not validated, the claim shall be denied and the player shall be notified promptly.
- B. To claim a prize of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), the player must sign the winning Ticket, fill out a claim form and present both at any Lottery Regional Office or mail both to the Minnesota State Lottery at the address printed on the back of the Ticket. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, a check shall be forwarded to the player for payment in the amount due less any appropriate debt set-off under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 270A and applicable federal and state withholding tax. In the event that the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claimant shall be denied and the player shall be notified promptly.
- C. To claim a prize of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00), the player must sign the winning Ticket, fill out a claim form and present both at the Minnesota State Lottery headquarters in Roseville, Minnesota. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, a check shall be forwarded to the player for payment

in the amount due less any appropriate debt set-off under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 270A and applicable federal and state withholding tax. In the event that the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claimant shall be denied and the player shall be notified promptly.

2.3. Allowance for Delay of Payment

The Lottery may delay payment of the prize pending a final determination by the Director under any of the following circumstances:

- a) if a dispute occurs or it appears likely that a dispute may occur regarding the prize;
- b) if there is any question regarding the identity of the claimant;
- c) if there is any question regarding the validity of the Ticket presented for payment; or
- d) if the claim is subject to any setoff for delinquent taxes or debts owed by the claimant under Minnesota Statutes, Section 349.08, subdivision 8.

2.4. Payment of Prizes to Person Under 18

No prize in the "CASINO GAME BOOK" scratch game may be paid directly to a person under 18 years of age.

2.5. Scratch Ticket Claim Period

All scratch game prizes must be claimed within one (1) year of the announced end of the scratch game. If the one (1) year deadline is a Saturday, Sunday or a legal holiday, a claim must be submitted by close of business the following business day.

3.0. Scratch Game Ticket Ownership

- A. Until such time as a signature is placed upon the back portion of a Scratch Game Ticket in the space designated therefor, a Ticket shall be owned by

the physical possessor of said Ticket. When a signature is placed on the back of the Ticket in the space designated therefor, the player whose signature appears in that area shall be the owner of the Ticket and shall be entitled to any prize attributable thereto. Notwithstanding any name or names submitted on a claim form, the Director shall make payment to the player whose signature appears on the back of the Ticket in the space designated therefor. If more than one (1) name appears on the back of the Ticket or more than one (1) person has agreed to share the prize and the prize being claimed is less than six hundred dollars (\$600.00), the Director will require that one (1) of those players whose name appears thereon or have agreed to share the prize be designated to receive payment. If more than one (1) name appears on the back of a Ticket or there is a valid agreement among more than one (1) person agreeing to share the prize and the prize being claimed is for the \$1,000.00, \$10,000.00 or the \$300,000.00 prize, the Director will make payment to each person who is a party to a valid prize sharing agreement.

B. The Lottery shall not be responsible for lost or stolen Scratch Game Tickets.

4.0 Number and Value of Prizes

There will be approximately 1,440,000 Tickets in Scratch Game No. 655. The expected number and value of prizes in the game are as follows:

The actual number of Tickets in the game may be increased or decreased at the sole discretion of the Lottery. The overall odds of winning a prize in Scratch Game No. 655 are 1:2.06.

5.0. Emergency Termination of the Scratch Game

The Director may, at any time, announce the termination of Scratch Game No. 655 without advance notice at which point no further Tickets in the scratch game may be sold.

6.0. Governing Law

In purchasing a Scratch Game Ticket, the player agrees to comply with and abide by these game procedures; Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 349A; the Lottery's Prize Payment Rules; and all final decisions of the Director.
