1.0. Name of Game

The name of Scratch Game No. 612 is "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game".

1.1. Price of the Scratch Ticket

- A. Tickets for Scratch Game No. 612 shall be five dollars (\$5.00) per Ticket.
- B. A retailer may discount the sales price of a Ticket in this game if the reduction in price is part of a storewide discount promotion on all purchases (lottery and non-lottery) made by the player. The discount of the price shall not relieve the retailer from the obligation to pay the Lottery the full price of a Ticket as stated in this section.

1.2. Definitions

- A. "Bar Code" means the unique bar-coded representation of the game Pack-Ticket Number and the Validation Number. This Bar Code will represent 20 decimal digits that include a three-digit Game Identification Number, a six-digit compressed Validation Number, a six-digit Pack Number, a three-digit Ticket Number and a two-digit Check Code. The Bar Code will be printed in black ink and be printed horizontally across the bottom of the back of the Ticket.
- B. "Display Printing" means that area of each Ticket outside of the area where the Play Symbols appear.
- C. "Non-Winning Ticket" means a Ticket that is not intended to be a winning Ticket or a Ticket that does not meet all the requirements of the Lottery's Prize Payment Rules, these game procedures and Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 349A.
- D. "Pack" means a pack of fan-folded "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Tickets that are attached to each other by perforations the retailer tears when the retailer sells a Ticket. These fan-folded Tickets are packed in plastic shrink-wrapping and consist of 100 tickets bearing a common Pack Number and having a Ticket number starting at 000 and continuing through 099.

E. "Pack-Ticket Number" means the 13-digit code printed in Pack-Ticket Number font in black ink in positive on the back of each Ticket in the form 000-000000-0-000. The first three (3) digits are the Game Identification Number, followed by a six-digit Pack Number, followed by a one-digit Check Digit, followed by a three-digit Ticket Number. Numbering begins with 612-000001-1-000 (the 1 is an example and does not reflect the actual check digit calculation for this Pack Number).

F. "Play Symbol" means the symbols that appear under the rub-off play area on each Ticket. Each Play Symbol is printed in Symbol Font in black ink in positive. There are three (3) types of Play Symbols in the "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game": "Winning Numbers" Play Symbols, "Your Numbers" Play Symbols and "Prize" Play Symbols. The possible Play Symbols are as follows:

1. "Winning Numbers" Play Symbols:



2. "Your Numbers" Play Symbols:





3. "Prize" Play Symbols:



G. "Ticket" or "Scratch Game Ticket" or "Scratch Ticket" means a "MINNESOTA TWINS® Scratch Game" No. 612 Ticket.

H. "Validation Number" means a game-wide, unique 10-digit Validation Number printed in Validation Font in black ink in positive located on the lower portion of the play area and will be covered with the latex and overprint.

2.0. Determination of Prizewinners

- A. The determination of winners is subject to the general Ticket validation requirements set forth in Section 2.1. of these procedures and the requirements set out on the back of each Scratch Game Ticket.
- B. A prizewinner in the "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" is determined when the play area on the Ticket is rubbed off to expose the four (4) "Winning Numbers" Play Symbols, the twenty (20) "Your Numbers" Play Symbols and the twenty (20) "Prize" Play Symbols on the front of the Ticket.
- C. The holder of a Ticket that reveals a "Your Numbers" Play Symbol that matches any of the "Winning Numbers" Play Symbols in the top area of the play area wins the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately below the "Your Numbers" Play Symbol that matches the "Winning Numbers" Play Symbol.
- D. The holder of a Ticket that reveals a  "Your Numbers" Play Symbol wins the amount indicated by the "Prize" Play Symbol immediately below the  "Your Numbers" Play Symbol.
- E. No portion of the display printing or any other extraneous matter whatever shall be usable or playable as part of the scratch game.
- F. The possible combined prizes that may be won in the "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" are:
- Five Dollars (\$5.00)
 - Seven Dollars (\$7.00)
 - Ten Dollars (\$10.00)
 - Fourteen Dollars (\$14.00)
 - Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)
 - Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00)
 - Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)
 - One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)
 - Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)
 - Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)
 - Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00)
 - Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)
 - One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)

2.1. Scratch Ticket Validation Requirements

- A. To be a valid "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Ticket, all of the following requirements must be met:

1. exactly four (4) "Winning Numbers" Play Symbols, exactly twenty (20) "Your Numbers" Play Symbols and exactly twenty (20) "Prize" Play Symbols must appear under the play area on the Ticket;
2. each Play Symbol must be present in its entirety and be fully legible;
3. each Play Symbol must be printed in black ink;
4. the Ticket must be intact;
5. the Validation Number and Pack-Ticket Number must be present in their entirety and be fully legible;
6. the Validation Number must correspond, using the Lottery's codes, to the Play Symbols on the Ticket;
7. the Ticket must not have a hole punched through it, be mutilated, altered, unreadable, reconstituted or tampered with in any manner;
8. the Ticket must not be counterfeit in whole or in part;
9. the Ticket must have been issued by the Lottery in an authorized manner;
10. the Ticket must not have been stolen nor appear on any list of omitted Tickets or non-activated Tickets on file at the Lottery;
11. the Play Symbols, Validation Number and Pack-Ticket Number must be right side up and not reversed in any manner;
12. the Ticket must be complete and not miscut, having exactly one (1) Validation Number and exactly one (1) Pack-Ticket Number on the Ticket;
13. the Validation Number of an apparent winning Ticket must appear on the Lottery's Official List of Validation Numbers of the Winning Tickets and a Ticket with that Validation Number must not have been previously paid;
14. the Ticket must not be blank or partially blank, misregistered, defective or printed or produced in error;
15. each of the Play Symbols must be exactly one (1) of those described in Section 1.2.F.;
16. each Play Symbol on the Ticket must be printed in Symbol Font and must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery;

17. the Ticket Validation Numbers must be printed in Validation Font and must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery;
 18. the Pack-Ticket Number must be printed in Pack-Ticket Number Font and must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery; and
 19. the display printing on the Ticket must be regular in every respect and correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery.
- B. The Ticket must pass all additional validation tests provided for in these game procedures, the Lottery's Prize Payment Rules and any confidential validation tests of the Lottery.
- C. Any Ticket not passing all the validation requirements may be considered void and be ineligible for any prize. However, the Director may:
1. replace the invalid Ticket with an unplayed Ticket in that scratch game;
 2. replace the invalid Ticket with a Ticket of equivalent sales price from any other current scratch game;
 3. refund the retail sales price of the Ticket; or
 4. pay the prize for the Ticket if enough of the validation requirements have been met to determine that the Ticket is not fraudulent.

2.2. Procedures for Claiming Scratch Prizes

- A. To claim a prize of five dollars (\$5.00), seven dollars (\$7.00), ten dollars (\$10.00), fourteen dollars (\$14.00), twenty dollars (\$20.00), twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), fifty dollars (\$50.00), one hundred dollars (\$100.00), two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or five hundred dollars (\$500.00), a player must sign the back of the Ticket in the space designated on the Ticket and present the winning Ticket to any lottery retailer or mail it to the Lottery at the address printed on the back of the Ticket. The lottery retailer shall verify the claim and, if valid, make payment of the amount due the player and physically void the Ticket. In the event the lottery retailer cannot verify the claim, the lottery retailer must provide the player with a claim form and instruct the player on how to file a claim with the Lottery. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, a check shall be forwarded to the player in the amount due. In the event the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim shall be denied and the player shall be notified promptly.

- B. To claim a prize of five thousand (\$5,000.00) or ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), the player must sign the winning Ticket, fill out a claim form and present both the Ticket and the claim form at any Lottery Regional Office or mail both to the Lottery at the address printed on the back of the Ticket. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, a check shall be forwarded to the player for payment in the amount due less any appropriate debt set-off under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 270A and any applicable federal and state withholding tax. In the event that the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim shall be denied and the player shall be notified promptly.

- C. To claim a prize of one hundred thousand (\$100,000.00), the player must sign the winning Ticket, fill out a claim form and present both at the Minnesota State Lottery headquarters in Roseville, Minnesota. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, a check shall be forwarded to the player for payment in the amount due less any appropriate debt set-off under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 270A and applicable federal and state withholding tax. In the event that the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claimant shall be denied and the player shall be notified promptly.

2.3. Allowance for Delay of Payment

The Lottery may delay payment of a prize pending a final determination by the Director under any of the following circumstances:

- a) if a dispute occurs or it appears likely that a dispute may occur regarding the prize;
- b) if there is any question regarding the identity of the claimant;
- c) if there is any question regarding the validity of the Ticket presented for payment; or
- d) if the claim is subject to any setoff for delinquent taxes or debts owed by the claimant under Minnesota Statutes, Section 349A.08, subdivision 8.

2.4. Payment of Prizes to Persons Under 18

No prize in the "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" may be paid to a person under 18 years of age.

2.5. Scratch Game Ticket Claim Period

All Scratch Game Ticket prizes must be claimed within one (1) year of the announced end of the game. If the one (1) year deadline is a Saturday, Sunday or a legal holiday, a claim must be submitted by the close of business the following business day.

3.0. Scratch Game Ticket Ownership

- A. Until such time as a signature is placed upon the back portion of a Scratch Game Ticket in the space designated therefor, a Ticket shall be owned by the physical possessor of said Ticket. When a signature is placed on the back of the Ticket in the space designated therefor, the player whose signature appears in that area shall be the owner of the Ticket and shall be entitled to any prize attributable thereto. Notwithstanding any name or names submitted on a claim form, the Director shall make payment to the player whose signature appears on the back of the Ticket in the space designated therefor. If more than one (1) name appears on the back of the Ticket and the prize being claimed is less than \$600.00, the Director will require that one (1) of those players whose name appears thereon be designated to receive payment. If more than one (1) name appears on the back of a Ticket or there is a valid agreement among more than one (1) person agreeing to share the prize and the prize being claimed is for the \$5,000.00, \$10,000.00 or the \$100,000.00 prize, the Director will make payment to each person who is a party to a valid prize sharing agreement.
- B. The Lottery shall not be responsible for lost or stolen Scratch Game Tickets.

3.0. Number and Value of Prizes

There will be approximately 2,400,000 Tickets in Scratch Game No. 612. The expected number and value of the prizes in the "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" are as follows:

The actual number of Tickets in the game may be increased or decreased at the sole discretion of the Lottery. The overall odds of winning a prize in the "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" are 1:3.5.

5.0. "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Drawing

The Lottery will conduct drawings in conjunction with Scratch Game No. 612.

5.1. Eligibility for "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Drawings

- A. A person may enter the "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Drawing (the "Promotion") by mailing a non-winning "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Ticket (Scratch Game #612) to the Lottery or by completing an entry form on www.mnlottery.com.
- B. Facsimile or photocopied non-winning "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Tickets are not permitted. The submission of a winning "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Ticket will invalidate that entry.
- C. A "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Ticket that is mailed must have all of the required information legibly completed on the Ticket, have the proper postage and be delivered through the U.S. Mail.
- D. For entries submitted via the Internet, the person must provide the required player information and the 10-digit Validation Number that appears under the latex of a "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Ticket.

- E. "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Tickets that are received by the Lottery prior to 5:00 p.m. CDT on May 25, 2009, or entered via the Internet by 11:59:59 p.m. CDT on May 25, 2009, are eligible for the 1st "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Drawing.
- F. "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Tickets received by the Lottery after 5:00 p.m. CDT on May 25, 2009, and prior to 5:00 p.m. CDT on August 3, 2009, or entered via the Internet after 11:59:59 p.m. CDT on May 25, 2009, and by 11:59:59 p.m. CDT on August 3, 2009, are eligible for the 2nd "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Drawing.
- G. "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Tickets received by the Lottery after 5:00 p.m. CDT on August 3, 2009, and prior to 5:00 p.m. CDT on October 19, 2009, or entered via the Internet after 11:59:59 p.m. CDT on August 3, 2009, and by 11:59:59 p.m. CDT on October 19, 2009, are eligible for the 3rd "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Drawing.
- H. The person whose name appears on the back of the "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Ticket or submits an entry via the Internet must be eligible to receive a Lottery prize under Minnesota law pursuant to a contract with the Lottery and pursuant to these procedures.
- I. The person whose name appears on the back of the "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Ticket or submits an entry via the Internet must be 18 years of age or older.
- J. The Lottery and the MLB Entities are not responsible for delayed, lost or misdirected mail or electronic submissions made through the Internet. The "MLB Entities" shall mean the Office of the Commissioner of Baseball, its Bureaus, Committees, Subcommittees and Councils, MLB Advanced Media, L.P. ("MLBAM" or "MLB.com"), Major League Baseball Enterprises, Inc., Major League Baseball Properties, Inc., the Major League Baseball Clubs (including, without limitation, the Minnesota Twins™), Tickets.com, Inc., SportsOnEarth, LLC and each of their subsidiaries or affiliated entities, any entity which, now or in the future, controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with the Major League Baseball Clubs or the Office of the Commissioner of Baseball, and the directors, officers, employees and agents of the above entities.
- K. A person may submit more than one (1) non-winning "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Ticket for the 1st, 2nd or 3rd "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Drawing.
- L. A "MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game" Ticket used for an entry may only be used once, either by mailing the Ticket to the Lottery or by entering it via the Internet. Entries mailed to the Lottery that have been previously entered via the Internet will be considered invalid.

- M. A non-winning “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket that is mailed to the Lottery within an envelope or other container is invalid.
- N. A “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket or entry is not valid for the 1st “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing if the person whose name appears on the back of a “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket or name submitted with the entry via the Internet has already been selected in the 1st “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing. A person may only be selected once in the 1st “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing.
- O. A “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket or entry is not valid for the 2nd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing if the person whose name appears on the back of a “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket or name submitted with the entry via the Internet has already been selected in the 2nd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing. A person may only be selected once in the 2nd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing.
- P. A “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket or entry is not valid for the 3rd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing if the person whose name appears on the back of a “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket or name submitted with the entry via the Internet has already been selected in the 3rd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing. A person may only be selected once in the 3rd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing.
- Q. If the person whose name appears on the back of a “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket or name submitted with the entry via the Internet has been awarded a 2010 Spring Training Trip, 2010 Regular Season Road Trip or a 2010 Regular Season Sampler Pack in a “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing, that person will be ineligible to receive a 2010 Spring Training Trip, 2010 Regular Season Road Trip or a 2010 Regular Season Sampler Pack in a subsequent “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing. If an entry is deemed ineligible under this paragraph, the entry will be considered eligible for the next level of prizes drawn in that “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing.
- R. If more than one (1) name appears on the back of the non-winning “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket, the Lottery will randomly select the person that will receive the prize among those names that appear on the back of the Ticket. Prizes cannot be shared.
- S. An entry will be considered invalid if the Ticket was used as an entry in any other Lottery promotion or second chance drawing.

- T. A “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Ticket mailed to the Lottery or entry submitted via the Internet will be considered invalid if it does not meet all of the requirements for eligibility stated in this section.

5.2. Selection of Tickets for the “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawings

- A. The Lottery will conduct the 1st “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing on or about May 28, 2009. The winners selected in the 1st “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing will be announced on or about June 2, 2009.
- B. The Lottery will conduct the 2nd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing on or about August 6, 2009. The winners selected in the 2nd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing will be announced on or about August 11, 2009.
- C. The Lottery will conduct the 3rd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing on or about October 22, 2009. The winners selected in the 3rd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing will be announced on or about October 26, 2009.
- D. The Lottery will select three hundred and ninety-six (396) entries in the 1st “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing, three hundred and ninety-five (395) entries in the 2nd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing and three hundred and ninety-five (395) entries in the 3rd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing.
- E. Except as provided in this paragraph, if the selected entry is deemed to be ineligible, an additional entry will be selected from the entries eligible for that drawing.
- F. The Lottery will, by use of mechanical or other devices, randomly determine which of the entries submitted are selected.
- G. The odds of any particular entry being selected in the 1st, 2nd or 3rd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing are dependent on the number of Tickets received and entries submitted via the Internet for the drawing and the eligibility of each of the Tickets and entries received.
- H. All Tickets received by the Lottery become the property of the Lottery and will not be returned to any player.

5.3. “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing Prizes

- A. In the 1st “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawing, the Lottery will award the following prizes to persons selected in the drawing:

1. One (1) 2010 Spring Training Trip.
 2. One (1) 2010 Regular Season Road Trip.
 3. Three (3) 2010 Regular Season Sampler Packs.
 4. Fourteen (14) 2010 Regular Season Party Suite Passes.
 5. Twenty-Seven (27) Regular Season Champion Club Seat Packages in 2010.
 6. Three hundred and fifty (350) Twins® Merchandise Prize Packs.
- B. In the 2nd and 3rd “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawings, the Lottery will award the following prizes to persons selected in the drawings:
1. One (1) 2010 Spring Training Trip.
 2. One (1) 2010 In-Season Road Trip.
 3. Three (3) 2010 Regular Season Sampler Packs.
 4. Fourteen (14) 2010 Regular Season Party Suite Passes.
 5. Twenty-Seven (27) 2010 Regular Season Champion Club Seat Packages.
 6. Three hundred and forty-nine (349) Twins® Merchandise Prize Packs.
- C. A 2010 Spring Training Trip consists of the following:
1. Airfare for two (2) persons at dates selected by the Minnesota Twins® in 2010 to Ft. Myers, Florida.
 2. Lodging for two (2) nights.
 3. Tickets to two (2) Minnesota Twins® spring training games.
- D. A 2010 Regular Season Road Trip consists of the following:
1. Airfare for two (2) persons at a date and location selected by the Minnesota Twins® for a Minnesota Twins® road game during the 2010 regular season.
 2. Lodging for two (2) nights.
 3. Two (2) tickets for two (2) Minnesota Twin® road games.
- E. A 2010 Regular Season Sampler Pack consists of two (2) tickets for nine (9) Minnesota Twins® games during the 2010 regular season. The dates for the games will be selected by the Lottery.
- F. A 2010 Regular Season Party Suite Pass consists of two (2) tickets for a Minnesota Twins® game during the 2010 regular season and food and nonalcoholic beverages. The date for the game will be selected by the Lottery.
- G. A 2010 Regular Season Champion Club Seat Package consists of two (2) champion club seats for a Minnesota Twins® game during the regular 2010 season. The date for the game will be selected by the Lottery.

- H. Each winner of a Minnesota Twins® Merchandise Prize Pack will receive ten (10) runs which may be redeemed for Minnesota Twins® merchandise selected by the winner. Each Minnesota Twins® merchandise item has a run value. A winner of a Minnesota Twins® Merchandise Prize Pack may select merchandise items that have a total value of ten (10) runs. The value of each Minnesota Twins® merchandise item is as follows:
1. Wind shirt – one (1) run.
 2. Seat cushion – one (1) run.
 3. Blanket – one (1) run.
 4. Fleece shirt – one (1) run.
 5. T-shirt, cap and water bottle combination – one (1) run.
 6. Classic jacket – two (2) runs.
 7. Etched glass collectible – two (2) runs.
 8. Ladies watch – two (2) runs.
 9. Fan pack consisting of a flag, logo chair and rolling cooler – three (3) runs.
 10. Men's watch – three (3) runs.
 11. Team black leather duffle bag – four (4) runs.
 12. Team backpack – four (4) runs.
 13. Authentic Collection® home jersey – five (5) runs.
 14. Collectible plaque – five (5) runs.
 15. Team leather varsity jacket – five (5) runs.
 16. Team leather duffle with logo bag tag – five (5) runs.
- I. The Lottery and the MLB Entities provide no warranties, guarantees or representations of any kind, express or implied, arising by law or otherwise, including, without any limitation, any implied warranty or fitness for a particular purpose or any implied warranty arising from course of performance, course of dealing or usage or trade in relation to any item included in a prize won in any of the “MINNESOTA TWINS™ Scratch Game” Drawings.
- J.
