HOT LOTTO SIZZLER PROCEDURES**

1.0. Name of the Hot Lotto Option

The name of the add-on option to the Hot Lotto Game is "Hot Lotto Sizzler".

1.1. Definitions

The definitions of the Hot Lotto Game Procedures apply to these procedures for Hot Lotto Sizzler.

1.2. Start of Hot Lotto Sizzler

Hot Lotto Sizzler will be offered to players beginning on January 3, 2008, with the first drawing, which includes the Hot Lotto Sizzler option on January 5, 2008.

2.0. Qualification for Hot Lotto Sizzler Prizes

To qualify for Hot Lotto Sizzler prizes, a person must purchase a Hot Lotto Sizzler play and pay an additional dollar for the Hot Lotto Sizzler option play (a "Qualifying Play").

2.1. Prizes to be Multiplied

A Qualifying Play which wins one (1) of the eight (8) set prizes will be multiplied by three (3). The grand prize jackpot is not a set prize and will not be multiplied.

2.2. Prize Pools

- A. Prize Reserve Accounts. The prize pool for all prize categories shall consist of approximately 47.42% of each drawing period's sales after the prize reserve accounts are funded to the amounts set by the MUSL Hot Lotto Product Group.
- B. Expected Prize Payout. Except as provided in these procedures, all prizes awarded shall be paid as set prizes. Instead of the Hot Lotto set prize amounts, qualifying Hot Lotto Sizzler plays will pay the amounts shown below:

In certain instances as provided in these procedures, the Hot Lotto set prize amount may be less than the amount shown. In such case, the Hot Lotto Sizzler prizes will be a multiple of the new Hot Lotto prize amount.

2.5. Limitation on Payment of Multiplied Prizes

If the total of the Hot Lotto set prizes and the multiplied Hot Lotto set prizes awarded in a drawing exceeds the percentage of the prize pools allocated to the set prizes, then the amount needed to fund the set prizes (including the multiplied set prizes) awarded shall be drawn from the following sources, in the following order: (i) the amount allocated to the set prizes and carried forward from previous draws, if any; (ii) an amount from the Hot Lotto Set-Prize Reserve Account, if available in the account, not to exceed one million dollars (\$1,000,000) per drawing. If, after these sources are depleted, there are not sufficient funds to pay the set prizes awarded (including multiplied prizes), then the highest set prize (including the multiplied prizes) shall become a pari-mutuel prize. If the amount of the highest set prize, when paid on a pari-mutuel basis, drops to or below the next highest set prize and there are still not sufficient funds to pay the remaining set prizes awarded, then the next highest set prize, including the multiplied prize, shall become a pari-mutuel prize. This procedure shall continue down through all set prizes levels, if necessary, until all set prize levels become pari-mutuel prize levels. In that instance, the money available from the funding sources listed in this rule shall be divided among the winning plays in proportion to their respective prize percentages. Prizes which, under these procedures, become pari-mutuel prizes may be rounded down so that prize can be paid in multiples of whole dollars. Breakage resulting from rounding these prizes shall be carried forward to the prize pool for the next drawing.

3.0. Governing Law

In purchasing a Qualifying Hot Lotto Sizzler Play, the player agrees to comply with and abide by these Hot Lotto Sizzler Procedures; the Minnesota State Lottery's game procedures for the Hot Lotto game; Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 349A; the Minnesota State Lottery's Prize Payment Rules; and all final decisions of the Director of the Minnesota State Lottery.
