

**OFFICIAL PROCEDURES  
MINNESOTA STATE LOTTERY  
“\$10,000 SPRING FOR CASH” PROMOTION**

1.0 Name of Promotion

The name of this promotion that will be conducted in conjunction with the Powerball with Power Play Game in 2008 will be the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion.

2.0 Definitions

- A. The definitions of the Powerball with Power Play Online Game Procedures apply to the procedures for the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion.
- B. The \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawing means the drawing conducted by the Lottery at Lottery headquarters in conjunction with the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion.

3.0 Duration of the Promotion

The \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion will begin on April 2, 2008, and conclude on April 30, 2008.

4.0 \$10,000 Spring for Cash Drawings

- A. The Lottery will conduct the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawings on or about April 15, 2008, April 22, 2008 and June 3, 2008.
- B. On April 15, 2008, one (1) entry will be selected from all eligible entries through the use of mechanical or other devices to receive \$1,000 cash.
- C. On April 22, 2008, one (1) entry will be selected from all eligible entries through the use of mechanical or other devices to receive \$1,000 cash.
- D. On June 3, 2008, one (1) entry will be selected from all eligible entries through the use of mechanical or other devices to receive a \$10,000 cash prize.
- E. A person may submit more than one (1) entry for any of the drawings.
- F. The Lottery is not responsible for delayed, lost or misdirected mail.
- G. The odds of an entry being selected in the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawing is dependent on the number of entries received for the drawing.
- H. All entries received become the property of the Lottery and will not be returned to any player.

#### 4.1 Eligibility for the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawing

- A. To be eligible for the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawing, a person must mail a non-winning Powerball with Power Play ticket purchased between April 2, 2008, and April 30, 2008, in an envelope no larger than 5" x 10" to the Lottery through the U.S. Mail to: \$10,000 Spring for Cash, P.O. Box 131235, Roseville, MN 55113-0011.
- B. The non-winning Powerball with Power Play ticket must have the person's name, address and daytime telephone number on the back of the ticket. If more than one (1) name appears on the ticket, any prize won will be equally split among each person whose name appears on the ticket.
- C. To be eligible for the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Drawing conducted on April 15, 2008, an entry must be received by the Lottery by 5:00 p.m. CDT on April 14, 2008.
- D. To be eligible for the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Drawing conducted on April 22, 2008, an entry must be received by the Lottery by 5:00 p.m. CDT on April 21, 2008.
- E. To be eligible for the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawing conducted on June 3, 2008, an entry must be received by the Lottery by May 30, 2008.
- F. An entry not selected in any drawing is eligible for any subsequent drawing in the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion.
- G. A person or any immediate family member (spouse, child, parent, brother or sister) residing in the same household may only be selected once in the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Preliminary Drawing.
- H. The person whose name appears on the ticket must be eligible to receive a lottery prize under Minnesota law pursuant to a contract with the Lottery and pursuant to these procedures.
- I. A facsimile or photocopy of a Powerball with Power Play ticket is not an eligible entry.
- J. The envelope must not contain any item other than a Powerball with Power Play ticket that would give the entry an undue advantage.
- K. An entry will be considered invalid if it does not meet all of the requirements for eligibility stated in this section.
- L. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, an entry will be considered valid if:

1. any of the information required to be provided on the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion ticket is illegible, but the envelope in which the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion ticket was included contains the illegible information.
2. the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion entry was mailed to the Lottery at the required post office box in a larger container or envelope, provided that each individual \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion entry is enclosed in an envelope no larger than 5" x 10".
3. the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion entry does not contain the person's daytime telephone number.
4. the envelope is not addressed to the correct address, but the Post Office deposits the envelope into the proper P.O. Box and it is delivered to the Lottery along with all of the properly addressed envelopes.

#### 4.2 Claiming a Prize from the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawing

- A. The person whose name appears on the back of the Powerball with Power Play ticket selected by the Lottery in any of the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawings will be notified after their ticket has been drawn and declared eligible.
- B. Each person whose name appears on the Powerball with Power Play ticket selected in a \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawing must fill out a claim form and submit it to the Lottery. If a winner of a prize in the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion is delinquent in the payment of state taxes or owes a debt as defined in Minnesota Statutes §270A.03, Subdivision 5, the amount due will be deducted from the value of the prize. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, the prize will be awarded to the player. In the event that the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim shall be denied and the player shall be notified immediately.
- C. If the person whose name appears on the selected entry does not present a completed claim form to the Lottery within 60 days from the date of the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion Drawing in which the entry was selected, that person(s) forfeits all rights that they may have had to the prize.
- D. Each person claiming a prize consents to the use of his or her name and or likeness for advertising, trade or promotional purposes without further compensation.

5.0 Governing Law

By participating in the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion and mailing an entry to the Lottery, the person agrees to comply with and abide by the game procedures for the \$10,000 Spring for Cash Promotion; Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 39A (the State Lottery law); Minnesota Rules, Chapter 7857 (the Lottery's Prize Payment Rules); and all final decisions of the Director of the Lottery.

**MINNESOTA STATE LOTTERY  
AMENDMENTS TO THE  
POWERBALL POWER PLAY PROMOTION**

**Minnesota State Lottery's Procedures for Powerball Power Play Promotion are amended. These amendments shall be effective beginning for the drawing on April 2, 2008, and shall remain in effect until the drawing on April 30, 2008, provided if the Power Play number 10 has not been selected during April 2008, these amendments will remain in force until the Power Play number 10 has been selected. The amendments are as follows:**

1. Section 2.2., "Power Play Drawings", is amended to read:

2.2.1. Power Play Drawings

MUSL will conduct a separate random "Power Play" drawing and announce results during each of the regular Powerball drawings held during the promotion. During each Powerball drawing, a single number from a series of 16 numbers will be selected. The numbers available for selection are 2, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5, 5, 10.

2. Section 2.3., "Prize Pools", Paragraph B, "Expected Prize Payout", is amended to read:

B. Expected Prize Payout. Except as provided in these rules, all prizes awarded shall be paid as set prizes. Instead of the Powerball set prize amounts, qualifying Power Play plays will pay the amounts shown below when matched with the Power Play number drawn:

In certain instances as provided in these procedures, the Powerball set prize amount may be less than the amount shown. In such case, the Power Play prizes will be a multiple of the new Powerball prize amount.

3. Section 2.4., "Probability of Prizes being Multiplied", is amended to read:

2.4. Probability of Prizes Being Multiplied

The probability of the various Power Play numbers being drawn during a single Powerball drawing, and a qualifying play being multiplied are as follows:

Power Play	Probability of Prize Increase
<u>10X</u>	<u>Prize Won Times 10 1 in 16</u>
5X -	Prize Won Times 5 1 in <del>4</del> <u>5.33</u>
<b>4X -</b>	<b>Prize Won Times 4 1 in 4</b>
<b>3X -</b>	<b>Prize Won Times 3 1 in 4</b>
2X -	Prize Won Times 2 1 in 4

**Power Play does not apply to the Powerball Grand Prize or to any Match 5 Bonus Prize.**
