“2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE”**

1.0. Name of Game

The name of the Minnesota Raffle Lotto Game conducted in 2009 is "2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE".

1.1. Definitions

- A. "Director" means the Director of the Minnesota State Lottery.
- B. "Drawing" means the formal process of selecting Winning Numbers.
- C. "Game Ticket" or "Ticket" means a Ticket produced by a Terminal for the "2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE" game. Each Ticket will contain a unique six-digit number issued sequentially across Minnesota, starting with 000001 and ending with 500000.
- D. "Lottery" means the Minnesota State Lottery.
- E. "Lotto Lottery Game" means the lottery game wherein a Ticket is produced by the Terminal.
- F. "Play" means the unique six (6) numbers from 000001 through 500000 that appear on a Ticket as a single numbered selection and are to be played by a player in the game.
- G. "Retailer" means a person or entity authorized by the Lottery to sell lottery game Tickets.
- H. "Terminal" means a device that is authorized by the Lottery to function in an online, interactive mode with the Lottery's computer system for the purpose of issuing lottery Tickets and entering, receiving and processing lottery transactions, including purchases, validating Tickets and transmitting reports.
- I. "Winning Numbers" means one of the 150 six-digit numbers randomly selected at the Drawing that shall be used to determine winning Plays contained on a Ticket.

2.0. Game Description

- A. "2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE" is a Lotto Lottery Game that pays set prizes and bonus prizes depending on the order in which the unique number is selected.

- B. To play “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE”, a player requests a Play in the “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE” Lotto Lottery Game from the Retailer. The Retailer will then issue a Ticket, via the Terminal, containing the next available unique number between 000001 and 500000, which constitutes a game Play. The Ticket will also designate the bonus prize that the Ticket holder is eligible to win.
- C. The sale of Tickets in the “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE” Lotto Lottery Game will begin on November 3, 2009, and end when 500,000 Tickets containing unique six-digit numbers between 000001 and 500000 have been issued or at midnight on December 31, 2009, whichever occurs first.

2.1. Claims

A Ticket shall be the only proof of a game Play or Plays and the submission of a winning Ticket to the Lottery or Retailer shall be the sole method of claiming a prize or prizes.

2.2. Player Responsibility

It shall be the sole responsibility of the player to verify the accuracy of the game Play or Plays and other data printed on the Ticket. The placing of Plays is done at the player's own risk through the Retailer who is acting on behalf of the player in entering the Play or Plays.

2.3. Price of Ticket

The price of each “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE” Ticket shall be \$10.00 and shall contain one (1) Play.

2.4. Ticket Characteristics and Restrictions

- A. The player shall request selection by Terminal of the unique six-digit number. The minimum Play amount is \$10.00. The Retailer will then issue a Ticket that shall contain the unique six-digit number, the Drawing date, amount bet, system control number data and the bonus prize that the ticket is eligible to win.
- B. The Ticket shall be the only valid proof of the bet placed and the only valid receipt for claiming a prize.
- C. A Ticket may not be canceled.

2.5. Time, Place and Manner of Conducting a Drawing

- A. The “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE” Drawing will be held on January 1, 2010.

- B. The “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE” Drawing will be conducted by the Lottery at Lottery headquarters.
- C. During the Drawing, the Lottery will first draw, at random, 110 unique numbers between 000001 and the last number sold to the public that will be known as the Winning Numbers for the set prizes after verification.
- D. After the Winning Numbers for the set prizes have been drawn, the Lottery will draw an additional 40 unique numbers between 000001 and the last number sold to the public that will be known as the Winning Numbers for the bonus prizes after verification.

3.0. Prize Pool

The prize pool for all prize categories shall consist of \$2,650,000.00.

3.1. Determination of Prize Winners

- A. The owner of a Ticket that contains the first two (2) numbers selected in the Drawing will be awarded a prize of \$1,000,000.00.
- B. The owner of a Ticket that contains the third through sixth numbers selected in the Drawing will be awarded a prize of \$100,000.00.
- C. The owner of a Ticket that contains the seventh through tenth numbers selected in the Drawing will be awarded a prize of \$25,000.00.
- D. The owner of a Ticket that contains the eleventh through one hundred and tenth number selected in the Drawing will be awarded a prize of \$500.00.
- E. The owner of a Ticket that contains any of the additional numbers selected for the bonus prize will win the bonus prize based on the bonus prize set and printed on that Ticket.

3.2. Bonus Prizes

- A. One (1) 2010 Ford Fusion Hybrid will be awarded. The 2010 Ford Fusion Hybrid includes payment of the sales tax, license fees and applicable state and federal withholding taxes on the prize. Total value of the Ford Fusion Hybrid prize is approximately \$40,598.00. The depiction of the Ford Fusion Hybrid Prize in any advertising or promotional material may not actually reflect the vehicle to be delivered to the winner. The actual specifications/features for the 2010 Ford Fusion Hybrid will be determined at the sole discretion of the Lottery.

- B. Two (2) Hawaii Vacation Prizes from Delta Vacations. Each Hawaii Vacation Prize includes round trip airfare for two (2) persons from any city in the United States (excluding cities in Alaska and Hawaii) that is serviced by Delta Airlines or Northwest Airlines to Hawaii, seven (7) nights' hotel lodging, \$2,000 in cash, and state and federal withholding taxes on the value of the prize. The total value of a Hawaii Vacation Prize is approximately \$9,151.00.
- C. Two (2) Caribbean Vacation Prizes from Delta Vacations. Each Caribbean Vacation Prize includes round trip airfare for two (2) persons from any city in the United States (excluding cities in Alaska and Hawaii) that is serviced by Delta Airlines or Northwest Airlines to any Delta Vacations destination in the Caribbean, four (4) nights' hotel lodging and \$1,000 in cash. The total value of a Caribbean Vacation Prize is approximately \$3,600.00.
- D. Two (2) Las Vegas Vacation Prizes from Delta Vacations. Each Las Vegas Vacation Prize includes round trip airfare for two (2) persons from any city in the United States (excluding cities in Alaska and Hawaii) that is serviced by Delta Airlines or Northwest Airlines to Las Vegas, Nevada, three (3) nights' hotel lodging and \$1,000 in cash. The total value of a Las Vegas Vacation Prize is approximately \$2,500.00.
- E. Two (2) Florida Vacation Prizes from Delta Vacations. Each Florida Vacation Prize includes round trip airfare for four (4) persons from any city in the United States (excluding cities in Alaska and Hawaii) that is serviced by Delta Airlines or Northwest Airlines to any Delta Vacations destination in Florida, four (4) nights' hotel lodging and \$1,000 in cash. The total value of a Florida Vacation Prize is approximately \$3,600.00.
- F. Two (2) Mexico Vacation Prizes from Delta Vacations. Each Mexico Vacation Prize includes round trip airfare for two (2) persons from any city in the United States (excluding cities in Alaska and Hawaii) that is serviced by Delta Airlines or Northwest Airlines to any Delta Vacations destination in Mexico, four (4) nights' hotel lodging and \$1,000 in cash. The total value of a Mexico Vacation Prize is approximately \$3,600.00.
- G. Four (4) Scratch Ticket Prizes. Each Scratch Ticket Prize includes \$500 in Minnesota State Lottery Scratch Lottery Tickets. The total value of a Scratch Ticket Prize is \$500.
- H. Four (4) Powerball Prizes. Each Powerball prize includes a coupon book for one hundred and four (104), five dollar (\$5.00) Minnesota State Lottery Powerball Tickets. The total value of a Powerball Prize is \$520.00.
- I. Three (3) Shopping Spree Prizes. Each Shopping Spree Prize includes a \$2,000 VISA gift card. The total value of a Shopping Spree Prize is \$2,000.00.

- J. Two (2) Home Theatre Prizes. Each Home Theatre Prize includes a home theatre system and \$1,000 in cash. The home theatre system includes a 46" Samsung LCD HDTV, Samsung 1000W 5.1 Ch. Home Theater with Blue-ray disc player, Monster power conditioner, Rocket Fish HDMI cable and Monster screen clean. The total value of a Home Theatre Prize is approximately \$3,468.00.
- K. Two (2) Computer Prizes. Each Computer Prize includes an Apple Mac Book Pro with 13.3" display, neoprene sleeve, wireless mouse and \$500 in cash. Total value of a Computer Prize is approximately \$1,978.00.
- L. Two (2) Furniture Prizes. Each Furniture Prize includes a \$3,000 gift certificate and \$1,000 in cash. Total value of a Furniture Prize is \$4,000.00.
- M. Two (2) Gunflint Lodge Resort Prizes. Each Gunflint Lodge Resort Prize includes four (4) nights lodging in a cabin with two (2) queen beds or one (1) king bed for two (2) adults at Gunflint Lodge Resort, four (4) dinners for two (2) persons, four (4) breakfasts for two (2) persons, three (3) lunches for two (2) persons (all meals at the Gunflint Lodge), a rental of a fishing boat with motor and canoe during the four (4) days stay, unlimited horseback riding during the four (4) days of the stay and \$500 in cash. Total value of a Gunflint Lodge Resort Prize is approximately \$2,250.00.
- N. Two (2) Breezy Point Resort Prizes. Each Breezy Point Resort Prize includes four (4) nights lodging in Breezy Center Lakeside Suite with two (2) double beds, unlimited golf with shared power cart during the four (4) days of the stay, all meals during the stay at Breezy Point Resort including nonalcoholic beverages (breakfast, lunch and dinner), and \$500 in cash. Total value of a Breezy Point Prize is approximately \$2,317.00.
- O. Two (2) Bluefin Family of Resort Prizes. Each Bluefin Family of Resort Prize includes three (3) nights lodging in a townhome for two (2) adults, meal allowance of \$200, and \$500 in cash. Total value of a Bluefin Family of Resort Prize is approximately \$1,800.00.
- P. Two (2) Rutgers Bay Lake Lodge Prizes. Each Rutgers Bay Lake Lodge Prize includes four (4) nights lodging for two (2) adults at Rutgers Bay Lake Lodge, four (4) dinners for two (2) persons, four (4) lunches for two (2) persons, four (4) breakfasts for two (2) persons (all meals at Rutgers Bay Lake Lodge), unlimited golf at Alec's Nine, two (2) rounds of golf with power cart on Lakes 18-hole championship course, one (1) day rental of a fishing boat with 15 hp motor and \$500 in cash. Total value of a Rutgers Bay Lake Lodge Prize is approximately \$2,485.00.
- Q. Two (2) Groceries Prizes. Each Grocery Prize includes a \$3,000 VISA gift card. Total value of a Groceries Prize is \$3,000.00.

- R. Two (2) Gas Prizes. Each Gas Prize includes a \$3,000 VISA gift card. Total value of a Gas Prize is \$3,000.00.
- S. Bonus prizes are subject to the following conditions:
1. All bonus prizes are not transferable, non-refundable and may not be exchanged for cash.
 2. All travel for any of the vacation prizes must be completed by January 1, 2012.
 3. Winners of vacation prizes will be responsible for travel to and from the airport serviced by such flights.
 4. For winners of a Hawaii, Caribbean, Las Vegas, Florida or Mexico vacation prize, travel is not permitted during the following dates: March 12 to April 3, 2010; November 19 to November 25, 2010; December 18, 2010 to January 1, 2011; March 11 to April 3, 2011; November 18 to November 24, 2011; and December 18 to December 31, 2011.
 5. All reservations for any vacation prize are subject to availability.
 6. Any certificate issued as part of a Hawaii, Caribbean, Las Vegas, Florida or Mexico vacation prize cannot be applied toward a previously purchased trip, combined with any other coupon, certificate, discount, bonus, infant fare, upgrade, Sky Miles or World Perks air travel award or promotional offer/tickets. Certificates issued as part of a vacation package may not be sold or transferred. Purchased certificates are subject to confiscation. Certificates issued as part of a vacation package may only be applied toward the number of passengers specified on the certificate. All passengers must travel on the same itinerary and must be booked through Delta Vacations. Any unused portion of a certificate issued as part of a vacation package will not be refunded and cannot be used towards another booking or another service component.
 7. For any booking for a Hawaii, Caribbean, Las Vegas, Florida or Mexico vacation prize, if the booking exceeds the value of the certificate value issued as part of a vacation prize, the recipient is responsible for any balance due which must be paid in full at the time of booking.
 8. For a Hawaii, Caribbean, Las Vegas, Florida or Mexico vacation prize, any hotel taxes that may apply are the sole responsibility of the winner.

9. For a Hawaii, Caribbean, Las Vegas, Florida or Mexico vacation prize, a \$15 fee for the first piece of checked luggage and a \$25 fee for a second piece of checked luggage may be assessed. Any such fees charged are the sole responsibility of the winner and are subject to change.
10. For a Hawaii, Caribbean, Las Vegas, Florida or Mexico vacation prize, once a reservation is made changes are not permitted. A per ticket surcharge will apply for paper tickets issued in markets where electronic ticketing is available. Any such fee charged is the sole responsibility of the winner.
11. All VISA gift cards and furniture gift cards must be redeemed by January 1, 2012.
12. The Home Theater System Prize and the Computer Prize must be ordered by January 1, 2012.
13. The Home Theater System Prize and the Computer Prize are subject to availability. The Lottery may substitute an item of comparable value at its discretion.
14. Applicable state and federal income taxes on any bonus prize is the sole responsibility of the winner.
15. The Lottery provides no warranties, guarantees or representations of any kind, express or implied, arising by law or otherwise, including, without any limitation, any implied warranty or fitness for a particular purpose or any implied warranty arising from course of performance, course of dealing or usage or trade in relation to any item included in a bonus prize.
16. The Lottery is not liable for any delays, accidents, taxes, fees or other additional expenses, including any debts, incurred as a result of the winner accepting a bonus prize.

3.3. Expected Prize Payout Percentages

All prizes awarded shall be paid as set cash prizes with the following expected prize payout percentages:

3.4. Probability of Winning

The following table sets forth the probability of winning and the probable distribution of winners in and among each prize category based upon 500,000 Tickets being sold. The actual probability will be based on the actual number of Tickets sold.

3.5. Prize Claim Period

Prize claims must be submitted by January 3, 2011.

3.6. Procedure for Claiming a Prize

- A. To claim a prize of five hundred dollars (\$500.00), a player shall sign the back of the Ticket in the space designated on the Ticket and present the winning Ticket to any Retailer. The Retailer shall verify the claim through use of the Terminal and, if valid, make payment of the amount due the player. In the event the Retailer cannot verify the claim, the Retailer shall provide the player with a claim form and instruct the player on how to file a claim with the Lottery. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, a check shall be forwarded to the player in the amount due. In the event the claim is not validated, the claim shall be denied and the player shall be notified promptly.

- B. To claim a prize of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00), the player must sign the winning Ticket, fill out a claim form and present both at any Lottery office or mail both to the Minnesota State Lottery, P.O. Box 131000, Roseville, MN 55113. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, a check in the appropriate amount will be forwarded to the player less any applicable federal and state withholding tax and debt owed under Minnesota Statutes 270A.03. In the event that the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim shall be denied and the player shall be notified promptly.
- C. To claim a prize of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) or one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00), the player must sign the winning Ticket, fill out a claim form and present both at the Lottery's main office in Roseville, Minnesota or at such other locations as may be authorized by the Director. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, a check in the appropriate amount will be forwarded to the player less applicable federal and state withholding tax and debt owed under Minnesota Statutes 270A.03. In the event that the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim shall be denied and the player shall be notified promptly.
- D. To claim the Ford Fusion Hybrid Bonus Prize, the player must sign the winning Ticket, fill out a claim form and present both at the Lottery's main office in Roseville, Minnesota or at such other locations as may be authorized by the Director. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, the Ford Fusion Hybrid Prize will be awarded to the player. In the event that the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim shall be denied and the player shall be notified immediately.
- E. To claim a bonus prize, other than the Ford Fusion Hybrid Prize, the player must sign the winning Ticket, fill out a claim form and present both at any Lottery office. If the claim is validated by the Lottery, the bonus prize will be awarded to the player. In the event that the claim is not validated by the Lottery, the claim shall be denied and the player shall be notified immediately. If a winner of a Hawaii, Caribbean, Las Vegas, Mexico or Florida Vacation Prize is delinquent in the payment of state taxes or owes a debt as defined in Minnesota Statutes §270A.03, subdivision 5, the amount due to the Department of Revenue under Minnesota Statutes §270A.03, subdivision 5 will be deducted from the cash portion of the bonus prize and any remaining cash and the non-cash portion of the bonus prize will be awarded to the winner. Winners of the Home Theatre or Furniture Prize must coordinate delivery from the store nearest to their residence.

4.0. Ticket Responsibility

- A. A "2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE" prize claim is deemed to be submitted by the person whose name appears on the Ticket or, in the case of a Ticket not completed with name and address, by the person holding the Ticket.

- B. The Lottery will not be responsible for lost or stolen “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE” Tickets.
- C. The purchaser of the “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE” Ticket has the sole responsibility for checking the accuracy and condition of the data printed on the Ticket.

4.1. Ticket Validation Requirements

- A. To be a valid “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE” Ticket, the following conditions shall be met:
 - 1. The Ticket system control number shall be present in its entirety and shall correspond, using the computer validation file, to the selected numbers printed on the Ticket for the date printed on the Ticket.
 - 2. The Ticket shall be intact.
 - 3. The Ticket may not be mutilated, altered, reconstituted or tampered with.
 - 4. The Ticket may not be counterfeit or an exact duplicate of another winning Ticket.
 - 5. The Ticket shall have been issued by the Lottery through a Retailer in an authorized manner.
 - 6. The Ticket may not have been stolen or canceled.
 - 7. The Ticket data shall have been recorded on the central computer system prior to the Drawing and the Ticket data shall match this computer record in every respect.
 - 8. The computer selected numbers, the system control number data and the Drawing date of an apparent winning Ticket shall appear in the official file of winning Tickets.
 - 9. The Ticket shall pass other confidential security checks of the Lottery.
- B. A Ticket not passing the validation checks in Subsection A will be considered invalid and will not be paid. In cases of doubt, the determination of the Director of the Lottery is final and binding.

4.2. Allowance for Delay of Payment

The Lottery may delay payment of the prize pending a final determination by the Director under any of the following circumstances:

- a) if a dispute occurs or it appears likely that a dispute may occur regarding the prize;
- b) if there is any question regarding the identity of the claimant;
- c) if there is any question regarding the validity of the Ticket presented for payment; or
- d) if the claim is subject to any setoff for delinquent debts owed by the claimant under Minnesota Statutes, Section 349A.08, subdivision 8.

No liability for interest for any delay shall accrue to the benefit of the claimant pending payment of the claim.

4.3. Payment of Prizes to Person Under 18

A prize in the “2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE” game may not be paid to a person under 18 years of age.

5.0. Ticket Ownership

- A. Until such time as a signature is placed upon the back portion of a Ticket in the space designated therefor, a Ticket shall be owned by the physical possessor of said Ticket. When a signature is placed on the back of the Ticket in the space designated therefor, the player whose signature appears in that area shall be the owner of the Ticket and shall be entitled to any prize attributable thereto.
- B. Notwithstanding any name or names submitted on a claim form, the Director shall make payment to the player whose signature appears on the back of the Ticket in the space designated therefor except as provided below.
- C. If more than one (1) name appears on the back of the Ticket or more than one (1) person has agreed to share the prize and the prize being claimed is for the \$500.00 prize or a bonus prize, the Director shall require that one (1) of those players whose name appears thereon or have agreed to share the prize be designated to receive payment.
- D. If more than one (1) name appears on the back of a Ticket or there is a valid agreement among more than one (1) person agreeing to share the prize as indicated on the Lottery claim form and the prize being claimed is for the \$25,000.00, \$100,000.00 or \$1,000,000.00 prize, the Director may make payment to each person who has agreed to shared the prize.

6.0. Governing Law

In purchasing a Ticket, the player agrees to comply with and abide by these game procedures for the "2009 MINNESOTA MILLIONAIRE RAFFLE" game; Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 349A (the State Lottery Law); the Lottery's Prize Payment Rules; and all final decisions of the Director.
