MEGA MILLIONS® MEGAPLIER® PROMOTION**

1.0. Name of the Promotion

The name of this promotion that will be conducted in conjunction with the Mega Millions® game will be Megaplier®.

1.1. Promotion Description

The Mega Millions® Megaplier® Promotion is a limited extension of the Mega Millions® game and is conducted in accordance with the Mega Millions® game procedures. The promotion will begin at the time announced by the Lottery and will continue until discontinued by the Lottery. The promotion will offer to the owners of a qualifying play a chance to multiply or increase the amount of any of the lump sum Set Prizes (the lump sum normally paying \$1.00 to \$1,000,000.00) won in a drawing held during the Promotion. The grand prize in the Mega Millions® game is not a Set Prize and will not be multiplied or increased by means of the Megaplier® Promotion.

1.2. Definitions

The definitions of the Mega Millions® game procedures apply to these procedures for the Megaplier® Promotion.

1.3. Start of Promotion

The Megaplier® Promotion will begin on January 31, 2010, with the first drawing on February 2, 2010.

2.0. Qualification for the Promotion

To qualify for the promotion (a "qualifying play"), a person must purchase a Megaplier® and pay an additional dollar per play for the Megaplier® option.

2.1. Prizes to be Multiplied

A qualifying play that wins one (1) of the lump sum Set Prizes will be multiplied by the number selected (2, 3, 4 or 5) in a separate random Megaplier® drawing announced in a manner approved by the MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group. The Grand Prize jackpot is not a Set Prize and will not be multiplied.

## 2.2. Megaplier® Drawings

MUSL will itself conduct or authorize a U.S. lottery to conduct, on its behalf, a separate random “Megaplier®” drawing. Before each Mega Millions® drawing, a single number (2, 3, 4 or 5) shall be drawn. The Mega Millions® lotteries may change one (1) or more of the multiplier features for special promotions from time to time. In the event the multiplier drawing does not occur prior to the Mega Millions drawing, the multiplier number will be a 5, which shall solely be determined by the Lottery.

## 2.3. Prize Pools

- A. Prize Reserve Accounts. The prize pool for all prize categories shall consist of up to 55% of each drawing period’s sales, as determined by the MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group, after the Mega Millions® prize reserve accounts are funded to the amounts set by the MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group. The Megaplier prize pool shall be carried forward to subsequent draws if all or a portion of it is not needed to pay the Megaplier prizes awarded in the current draw and held in the Megaplier Pool Account.
- B. Megaplier Prize Pool Accounts. Any amount not used to pay for multiplied prizes may be collected and placed in the Megaplier Prize Pool until the prize pool account reaches the amounts designated by the MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group. Any amount remaining in the Megaplier Prize Pool Account at the end of this game shall be carried forward to a replacement game or expended in a manner as directed by the Product Group in accordance with law.
- C. Expected Prize Payout. Except as provided in these rules, all prizes awarded shall be paid as lump sum set prizes. Instead of the Mega Millions® set prize amounts, qualifying Megaplier® plays will pay the amounts shown below when matched with the Megaplier® number drawn:

Multiplier numbers do not apply to the Mega Millions® Grand Prize. In certain instances as provided in these procedures, the Mega Millions® set prize amount may be less than the amount shown. In such case, the Megaplier® prizes will be a multiple of the announced Mega Millions® prize amount.

## 2.4. Probability of Prizes Being Multiplied

The probability of the various Megaplier® numbers being drawn during a single Mega Millions® drawing. The MUSL Mega Millions® Product Group may elect to run limited promotions that may modify the multiplier features.

Multiplier numbers do not apply to the Mega Millions Grand Prize.

## 2.5. Limitation on Payment of Multiplied Prizes

- A. The prize pool percentage allocated to the Megaplier® set prizes shall be carried forward to subsequent draws if all or a portion of it is not needed to pay the set prizes awarded in the current draw or may be held in a prize reserve account.
- B. Except as otherwise provided for herein, if the total of the original Mega Millions set prizes and the Megaplier prize amounts awarded in a drawing exceeds the percentage of the prize pools allocated to the set prizes, then the amount needed to fund the set prizes (including the Megaplier prize amounts) awarded shall be drawn from the following sources in the following order: (i) the amount allocated to the set prizes (including Megaplier prize amounts) and carried forward from previous draws, if any; (ii) an amount from the Mega Millions Prize Reserve Account, if available in the account, not to exceed forty million dollars (\$40,000,000.00) per drawing.
- C. If, after these sources are depleted, there are not sufficient funds to pay the set prizes awarded (including Megaplier prize amounts), then the highest set prize (including the Megaplier prize amounts) shall become a pari-mutuel prize. If the amount of the highest set prize, when paid on a pari-mutuel basis, drops to or below the next highest set prize, including the Megaplier amount, shall become a pari-mutuel prize. This procedure shall continue down through all set prizes levels, if necessary, until all set prize levels become pari-mutuel prize levels. In that instance, the money available from the funding sources listed in this rule shall be divided among the winning plays in proportion to their respective prize percentages. Mega Millions and Megaplier prizes will be reduced by the same percentage.

## 2.6. Prize Payment

- A. All Megaplier® prizes shall be paid in one (1) lump sum by the Lottery. The

Lottery may begin paying Megaplier® prizes after receiving authorization to pay by the MUSL.

- B. Prizes that, under these game procedures, may become pari-mutuel prizes may be rounded down so that prizes can be paid in whole dollars. Breakage resulting from rounding these prizes shall be carried forward to the prize pool for the next drawing.

### 3.0. Governing Law

In purchasing a qualifying play in the Megaplier® Promotion, the player agrees to comply with and abide by these promotional procedures for the Megaplier® Promotion; the Minnesota State Lottery's game procedures for the Mega Millions® game; Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 349A; the Minnesota State Lottery's Prize Payment Rules and all final decisions of the Director of the Minnesota State Lottery.
